



Covid-19 Safety Protocols

Cerebral Palsy of Westchester is committed to doing everything possible to provide a safe and healthy environment for all at its upcoming Harvest Moonlight Soiree on Thursday, October 21 at Crawford Park Mansion in Rye Brook. We have limited the number of guests to allow for easy social distancing. Consistent with CDC and New York State Department of Health guidelines, fully vaccinated guests are not required to wear face coverings inside the mansion. However, guests who are not fully vaccinated against COVID-19 must continue to wear a face covering over their nose and mouth when indoors, except when actively eating or drinking. Anyone who wishes to wear a mask, for any reason, inside or outside, should do so.

All catering staff will be wearing face coverings; this includes during food preparation and while serving guests. Hand sanitizing stations will be conveniently placed throughout the mansion, and face coverings will be available upon request. Weather permitting, the mansion doors and large windows will be open facing the front and side patios, allowing for the circulation of fresh air and movement of guests between the indoor and outdoor spaces. This will allow for enhanced social distancing to take place.

Please stay home if you have tested positive for COVID-19, are waiting for COVID-19 test results, have COVID-19 symptoms, or if you have had close contact with a person who has tested positive for or who has symptoms of COVID-19.
