Saturday Explorers

The Saturday Explorers program meets every Saturday from 10am to 2pm and is designed to promote the benefits of recreation activities for children and young adults with special needs.

Activities include arts and crafts, music and dance, game room activities (board games, Wii, Youtube) and holiday events, as well as outdoor time at our adaptive playground Harmony Park.

Activities are held on our Rye Brook campus. Each activity is guided by a leader and adapted to fit everyone's needs to ensure meaningful participation. OPWDD Waivers are accepted for children who are eligible for services through the Office for People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD). Private pay and Self-Direction options are also available.

Adaptive Recreation Program

CPW hosts an adaptive program during the school breaks. With a focus on building relationships through socialization and group activities, the program engages children, teenagers and young adults in adaptive recreational activity, programs and creative arts.

The program is open to individuals, ages 6 and up, on the autism spectrum as well as those with differing abilities.
